## Prerequisites:

- EMT certification in the State of Ohio
- Basic Life Support (BLS) for Health Care Provider certification
- Five years of experience as an EMS provider in the last seven years
- Successful completion of a National Registry Cognitive Examination for their level of certification
- Successful completion of a practical examination for their level of certification

This 70-hour course meets all the requirements of the State of Ohio Division of EMS in order to certify as an EMS Instructor. Instructional hours will include, at least:

- 50 hours in instruction of adult students and basic teaching techniques
- 8 hours in instruction specific to the field of emergency medical services
- 10 hours of supervised teaching in the presence of an EMS instructor (To be arranged outside of class)

The student's performance will be evaluated through written and practical testing prior to issuance of a certificate of completion.
