Prerequisites:

- *Paramedic certification in the State of Ohio.*
- *Basic Life Support (BLS) for Health Care Provider certification.*

This 48-hour course meets all the requirements of the State of Ohio Division of EMS in order to re-certify as a Paramedic.

Instructional hours will include, at least:

- Eight hours on trauma issues, (including two hours pertaining to triage and transportation protocols), ITLS recertification
- Twelve hours on pediatric issues
- Ten hours on medical emergencies
- Four hours on geriatric issues
- Six hours on cardiology, ACLS Recertification
- Four hours on airway and ventilation
- Two hours on EMS operations
- Two hours on obstetrics and gynecology

The student's performance will be evaluated through written and practical testing prior to issuance of a certificate of completion.
