Miami Valley Hospital Beavercreek Emergency Center will accept all patients with minor to severe injuries or conditions.

## Open 24/7, the center will feature:

- Twelve emergency beds, including two trauma bays, staffed by board-certified emergency medicine physicians from Miami Valley Hospital, Dayton's most experienced Level I Trauma Center
- Able to receive 12 lead EKG via Lifenet Software
- Stroke Telemedicine tPA capable
- Ability to land CareFlight helicopter or transport patients via Mobile Intensive Care Unit (MICU)
- Decontamination ready for Hazmat exposure. Call ahead to initiate a rapid response for Hazmat.
- Enhanced capability to keep patients who require a less than 24-hour length of stay for observation
- Community room that you may reserve for meetings and trainings

Our spacious EMS room has been designed with your needs in mind. For your convenience and to get you back into service faster, it includes:

- Computer work stations
- Drug bag and equipment exchange conveniently located in the Emergency Center
- Storage cabinets for equipment returns

- Phone charging station



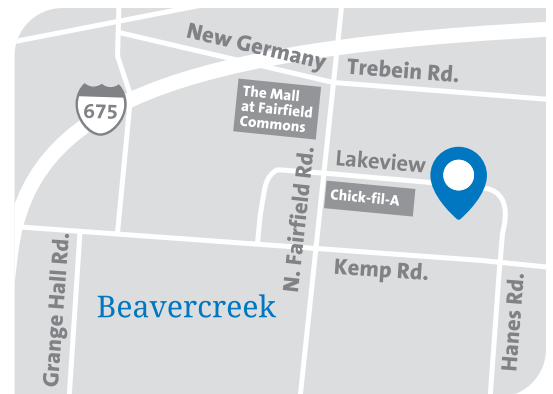
