





Richmond Police Officer Seara Burton's Funeral Detail

A funeral ceremony will be held for Richmond, Indiana Police Officer Seara Burton who was shot in the line-of-duty on August 10 while conducting a K-9 search during a traffic stop. She succumbed to her injuries on September 18. The funeral ceremony is scheduled for Monday, September 26 at 11:00 A.M. at Richmond High School's Tiernan Center, 380 Hub Etchison Parkway, Richmond, Indiana. A public visitation is scheduled for Sunday, September 25 from 2:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. at the Richmond City Building, 50 North Fifth Street. Any department wishing to send officers and public safety vehicles to the funeral ceremony with other representatives from across the Miami Valley, please meet at the Dayton Airport Expo Center, 3900 McCauley Drive by 8:00 A.M. on Monday morning to caravan to Richmond. The procession will depart the Expo Center promptly at 8:30 A.M. and proceed to the funeral service. Officers should wear your department's Class "A" uniform (long sleeve shirt, tie, and hat) and have a mourning ribbon over your badge. Monday's weather forecast is partly cloudy with temperatures in the mid 60's during the afternoon. After the funeral, there will be a processional to Crown Hill Cemetery, 700 38th Street, Indianapolis. Agencies may use their discretion in participating in the 75-mile funeral procession from Richmond to Indianapolis.

A continental breakfast and beverages will be provided compliments of the Montgomery County Police Memorial committee. Please arrive early for assembly of public safety vehicles in the staging area prior to heading to Richmond.
