Good Day!

A quick update:

- 1. The 2024 Skill Evaluator Tests are open. As in previous years, there are 50 questions pulled mostly from the 2024 Protocol and a few questions from the Training Manual and the Implementation Guide. It is still an open resource test with a 45-minute time limit. Passing threshold for Skill Evaluator status is 90% within 2 attempts annually. 84% is still the minimum to earn CE and function with the appropriate Ohio EMS certification.
- 2. Please let us know if your access code does not work (remember the dashes). This was an issue last year that we believe is now resolved for the 2024 tests.
- 3. There is an electronic form in the Implementation Guide that all departments' highest authority (Chief, CEO, President, etc.) are required to complete annually. It is an attestation that the department will comply to the rules set forth in the Implementation Guide. This is a critical component of both the GMVEMSC Protocol and the Drug Bag Program.
- 4. The regular test cycle will start soon (March 15th). We are waiting a few weeks to allow the skill evaluators to "test the test."
