



The Troy Fire Department is seeking qualified individuals that want to grow with a great community. We are looking to hire full-time candidates who are professional, caring, and looking to invest in a rewarding career. To be considered, candidates must have obtained their State of Ohio Firefighter Level II/Paramedic, or Firefighter Level II/EMT Basic certifications.

**Salary:** \$48,991.28 for entry level Firefighter/EMT and \$54,434.75 for entry level Firefighter/Paramedic. Firefighter/Paramedics after three years of service will have a salary of \$76,867.23. Firefighter/Paramedics may be eligible, upon hire, to be placed in an equivalent Firefighter/Paramedic compensation steps.
