State Routes 725, 4 & 123 run through our district, which is mostly rural township with the historic 1804 city located within. Germantown is a short 25 minute drive south from downtown Dayton, 15 minutes west of Miamisburg and 15 minutes north from Middletown.

Part-time staff will handle a variety of duties to include emergency medical response, fire suppression, safety and prevention, inspections, building and equipment maintenance, training, and other duties related to Fire-EMS services. With growth in the City and Township we have upgraded into a brand new Fire-EMS Station with beautiful kitchen/living space, five new bunkrooms along with 4 pull through apparatus bays, training room, fitness room, etc.
