

Career Firefighter-Paramedic Hiring Process



The Madeira & Indian Hill Joint Fire District will begin a process to establish an eligibility list to fill a position available immediately. The list will also be use for any future vacancy(ies) for the position of Career Firefighter-Paramedic.

The Firefighter-Paramedic (Career) position is responsible for performing advanced emergency medical procedures, firefighting and rescue duties; participation in fire station and equipment maintenance, engaging in training; participation in fitness programs and other related duties. A complete job description will be available at time of application.

Qualifications for application:

- At least 21 years of age
- Non-smoker/tobacco user
- High school diploma or GED
- Ohio Firefighter II, Emergency Medical Technician at time of employment and Ohio Paramedic by the end of probation
- Valid driver's license

The testing process for possible appointment to a career Firefighter- Paramedics position will ultimately include multiple components. Candidates with five (5) or more years of experience as a full-time Firefighter, with a pension-participating department and less than 15 years of such experience, may choose to apply for lateral transfer consideration and forego the written assessment.

IMPORTANT: A certificate of successful completion of the IAFF/IAFC Candidate Physical Abilities Test (CPAT) OR the Firefighter Mile in the previous twelve months is among the required components for appointment.

Starting salary: \$65,169—\$89,843 Annually depending on qualifications
after 30 months Firefighter / Paramedic top salary: \$97,363
