Sinclair Community College, Ohio accreditation number 326, has openings for adjunct faculty. Adjuncts provide the majority of education within the EMS laboratory/clinical setting. These faculty will teach all aspects of EMS from emergency medical responder to paramedic. Examples of topics taught include: patient assessment, medication access and administration, airway management, trauma management, and medical management. Faculty need to be both excellent at teaching psychomotor skills and understanding the rationales behind each step.

The successful candidates will have a background in EMS including:

- Ohio licensed Paramedic
- Ohio licensed EMS Instructor (full 72 hour course)
- AHA ACLS Instructor
- AHA CPR Instructor
- At least 2 year of paramedic level patient care experience
- At least 1 year of providing EMS education

The selection process will be based on:

- Evidence of current EMS knowledge (need only one)
  - Taken and passed NREMT CBT examination within the past 2 years
  - Taken and passed the paramedic level comprehensive final created by Sinclair Community College within the past year.
  - Taken and passes the BCCTPC examination for critical care paramedic
- Mock teaching presentation
- Interview with department chairperson
