Firefighter/Paramedic (Full-time)

February 1, 2018 – The City of Bellbrook, Ohio, is currently accepting applications for the full-time position of Firefighter/Paramedic. Duties include fire prevention, emergency medical service, hazardous material response, search and rescue, and disaster assistance. The Bellbrook Fire Department is a combination Fire and EMS department with full-time, part-time and volunteer staff. The department serves a community of 7,000 residents from two fire stations.

At the time of application, the applicant must provide copies of the following current certifications: (1) Firefighter II – State of Ohio, (2) EMT-Paramedic – State of Ohio, (3) Advanced Cardiac Life Support Provider, (4) Hazardous Materials Operation, (5) CPR card, and (6) NIMS ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-800, and IS-700 training certificates, (7) a certificate dated 2/16/17 or newer from Kettering Sports Medicine or a CPAT certificate, (8) possess and maintain a valid Ohio driver's license and be insurable under the city's vehicle insurance plan, and (9) a high school diploma or equivalent. Ohio Fire, EMS and/or CPR Instructor certificates are preferred.

Starting pay rate is \$20.39 per hour.

Incomplete application submittals will not be considered. The deadline to apply (or materials postmarked) is **February 16, 2018**.

The selection process includes: a review of the cover letter, resume, and employment application. The process may include written/video tests, assessment centers, oral board, additional interviews and polygraphs. The final candidate will be required to complete a background investigation. The appointment procedure will be based on the number of qualified candidates. The Fire Chief may waive certain requirements to ensure an adequate candidate pool.
