Certification, Licensure, Registration:

- Licensed as an EMT-B, EMT-I, or EMT-P in the state of Ohio, maintained in good standing.
- Must possess a current American Heart Association CPR certification, maintained in good standing.
- EMT-P employees must also possess a current American Heart Association ACLS and PALS certification, maintained in good standing.
- Must possess a valid State Driver's License and be eligible for driving privileges based on current department policies and procedures. Must also pass a background check.

Knowledge, Skills And Abilities Required:

- Minimum Education: Must possess a High School Diploma or equivalent. Where applicable and as required must maintain Continuing Education.
- Contact With Others: Co-workers, clients, patients and families, medical personnel. Must be able to write, read and speak English fluently.
- Analytical Demands: Must be able to think and act calmly and quickly in emergency situations.

Working Conditions:

- Physical Effort: Physical demands including lifting, climbing, pushing, stooping, bending, kneeling and crouching, and otherwise maneuvering heavy patients, with stretchers and equipment (at least 250 pounds).
- Work Environment: Works outdoors, in weather common to the region, on a regular basis. Exposure to blood, body fluids or tissue.
