- To receive a booster dose it must have been at least 6 months from your 2nd dose vaccination for Pfizer and Moderna and 2 months since your Johnson & Johnson vaccination.
- Ages 12 to 17, 1st & 2nd dose only. Must have a parent or guardian present.

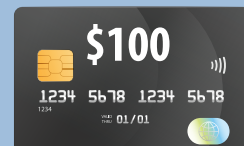
